



## **Greenscapes-Recommended Plants**

These plants were selected because they are drought tolerant, hardy, widely available and require little maintenance once they are established. See below for a list of garden centers on the North Shore that will give a 15% discount on these plants if you mention the Greenscapes program.

- Sedum Autumn Joy (*Sedum x 'Autumn Joy'*)
- Purple Dome New England Aster (*Aster novae-angliae 'Purple Dome'*)
- Stella D'oro Daylily (*Hemerocallis*)
- Liatris (*Liatris species*)
- Purple Coneflower (*Echinacea purpurea*)
- Blanket Flower (*Gaillardia aristata*)
- Moonbeam Coreopsis (*Coreopsis verticillata*)

### **Ornamental Grasses:**

- Big Bluestem (*Andropogon gerardii*)
- Little Bluestem (*Schizachyrium scoparium*)
- Feather Reed Grass (*Calamagrostis x acutiflora 'Karl Foerster'*)

### **Shrubs:**

- American Cranberry Viburnum (*Viburnum trilobum*)
- Virginia Sweetspire (*Itea virginica*)
- Fothergilla (*Fothergilla species*)
- Northern Bayberry (*Myrica pensylvanica*)
- Winterberry (*Ilex verticillata*)

### **Groundcovers:**

- Bearberry (*Arctostaphyllum uva ursi*)
- Barren Strawberry (*Waldstenia fragarioides*)
- Pussy-toes, Everlasting (*Antennaria rosea*)
- Creeping Phlox (*Phlox subulata*)

### **Trees**

- River Birch (*Betula nigra*)
- Serviceberry (*Amelanchier*)
- Pin Oak (*Quercus palustris*)
- Eastern Red Cedar (*Juniperus virginiana*)
